We ask you not to submit a paper that has been accepted for publication in a journal or is close to being accepted.

Sample topic areas include, but are not limited to:

- Behavior of different investor types (e.g., individuals, or institutional investors like mutual funds or hedge funds), and their impact on asset prices
- Market microstructure and investor trading behavior
- Behavioral biases and performance of investment strategies
- Household consumption, borrowing, saving, and portfolio choice
- Behavioral corporate finance
- Investor education, financial literacy, and sophistication
- Behavior of finance professionals and the impact of professional advice
- Biological, psychological, and cultural foundations of investor behavior
- The influence of analysts, media, and news coverage on investment decisions
- Social influence and networks in finance
